### **Items for Information and Discussion**

**A. RFP: NMHS Tennis Courts** We have reached out to potential landscape architects to better understand the design process and the requirements for USTA grant guidance.

**B. RFP: Central Offices A&E** We met with engineers from Silver Petrucelli to review the scope of work for the Business and Assistant Superintendent's offices. We plan to execute this work during the summer recess.

**C. RFP: NMHS Culinary A&E** Programming for the future culinary room at NMHS is underway. We are working with Antinozzi Architects to develop a layout, cost estimates, and conceptual drawings for the space.

**D. NES Roof** The Town has posted an RFP for architectural and engineering (A&E) services for the Northville Elementary School roof. Bids are scheduled to be opened on March 12, 2026.
